THE HARBOUR BAR

Locals will tell you The Harbour Bar is more than a pub, it's an institution in Bray and beyond.

Hailed as scruffy, wild and elegant, The Harbour Bar is a true destination pub with unmatched character. It's décor is made up of curios and mementos collected over its one and a half century history and help give the bar it's unique character. Established in 1872, it was bought by James O'Toole in 1932. The bar was once both a bar and undertakers, and rumour has it that it is immortalised somewhere in James Joyce's Finnegan's Wake. Joyce is one of many celebrated people who patronised the bar over its long history.

The bar was voted The Best Bar in the World by Lonely Planet in 2010 and is recognised as a pub with an authentic and fun atmosphere and a passion for good music.

The Harbour Bar is open daily from 12pm offering great pints, delicious toasties and seafood, trad music and more.

Areas of The Harbour Bar:

THE SNUG is the spot to snag for a quiet pint and a chat with the day's papers laid out to peruse.

THE BAR bustles with its trad sessions with musicians and the customers in full song.

THE GOOD ROOM has a roaring fire and board games just like Granny's

THE LIVE LOUNGE is where to go to see the best live music acts in Bray. Best thing, it's all free.

THE BEER GARDEN is heated when needed, perfect for taking in the sea air and a pint with the dog.
